





Sound is waves of energy

vibrations fly EVERYWHERE!










IT'S vibrating air that travels fast

So I hear things loud and clear.







First is my outer ear, or pinna

On my eardrum which works just fine!







And when my eardrum starts to shake

It looks like a snail's shell




I also have semi-circular canals in there

Keeps me standing straight and tall






But if I spin this liquid round
