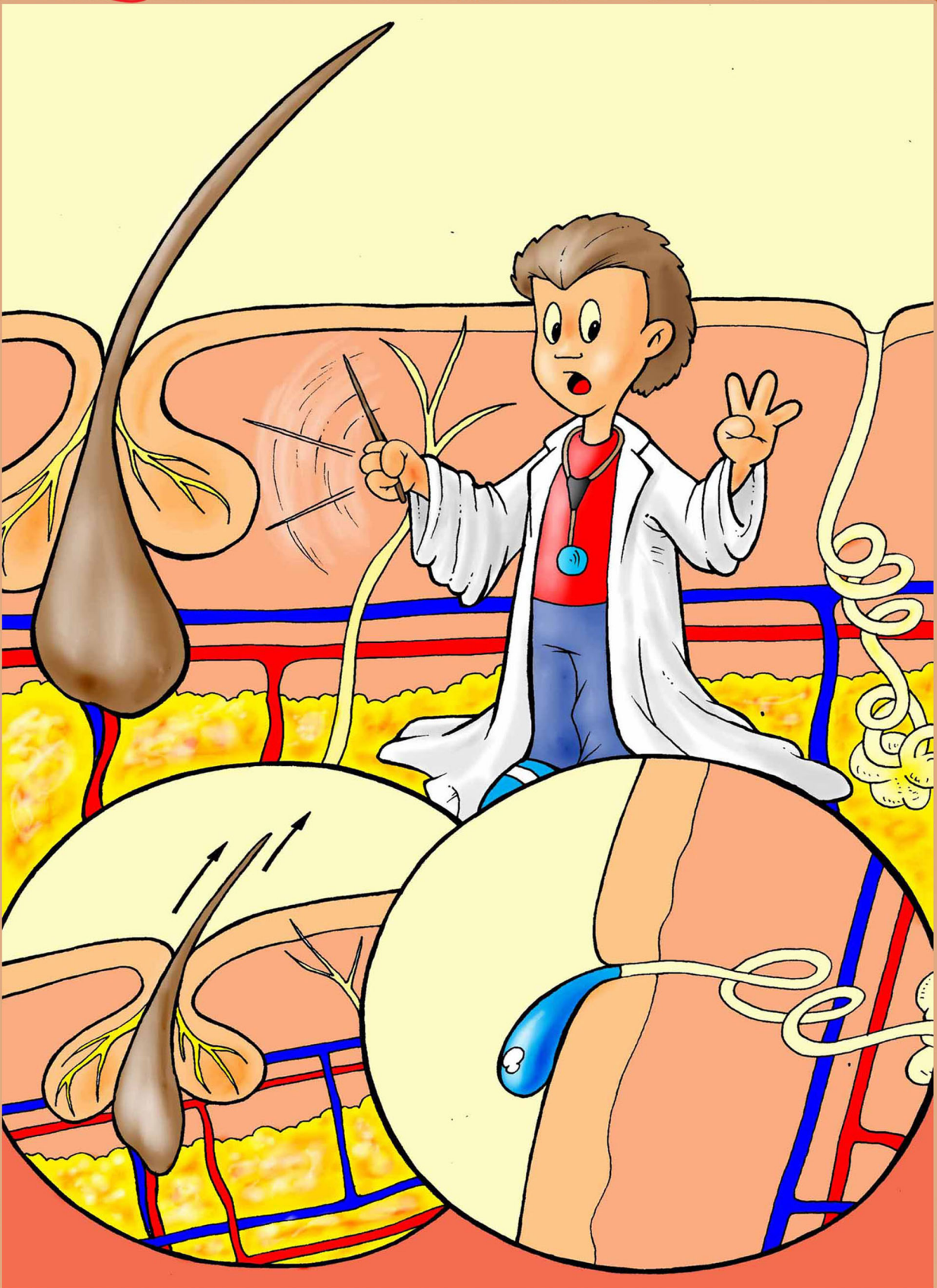


On the outside of my body
Is an organ called the skin

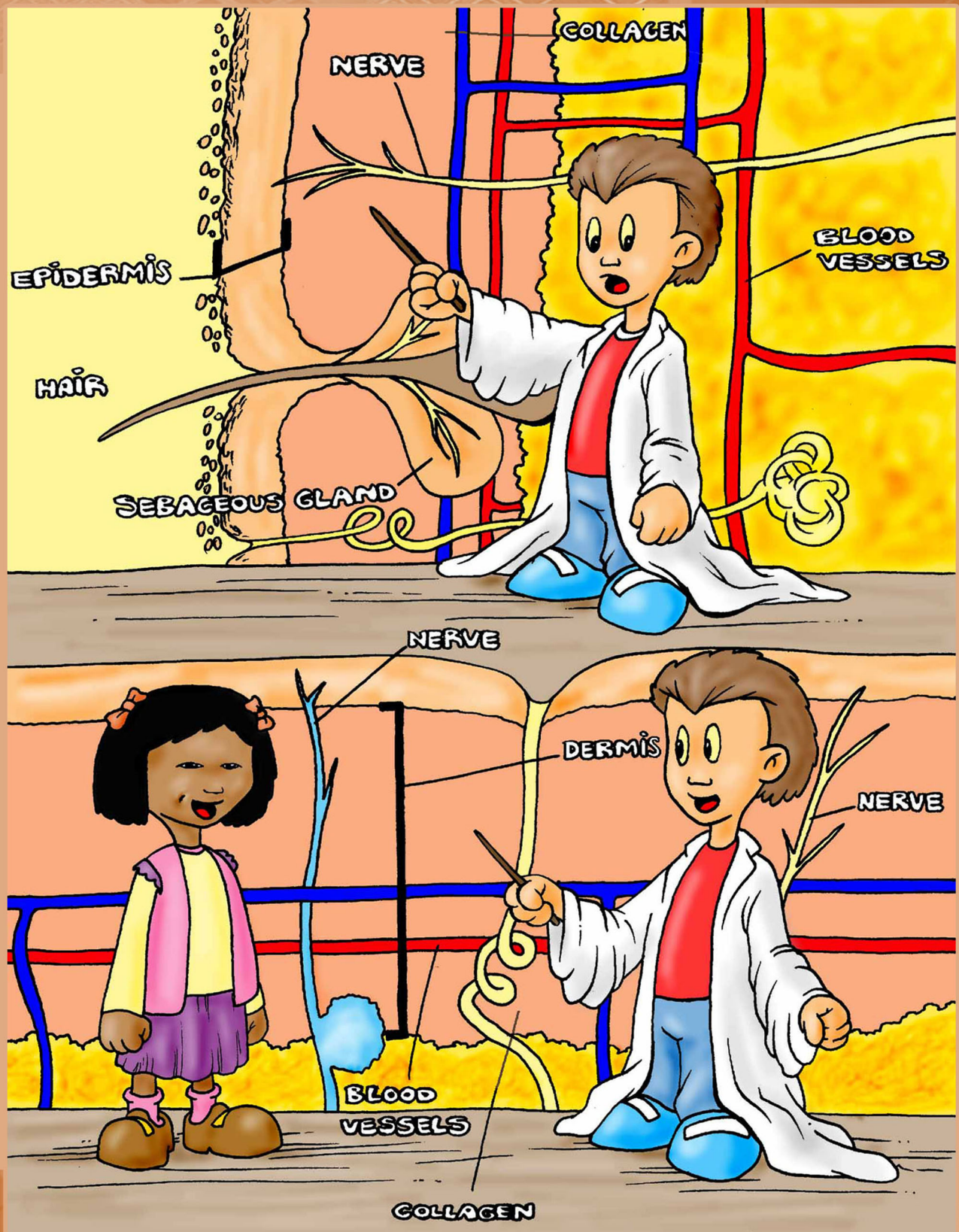




It protects me from infection
And it keeps my inside in.

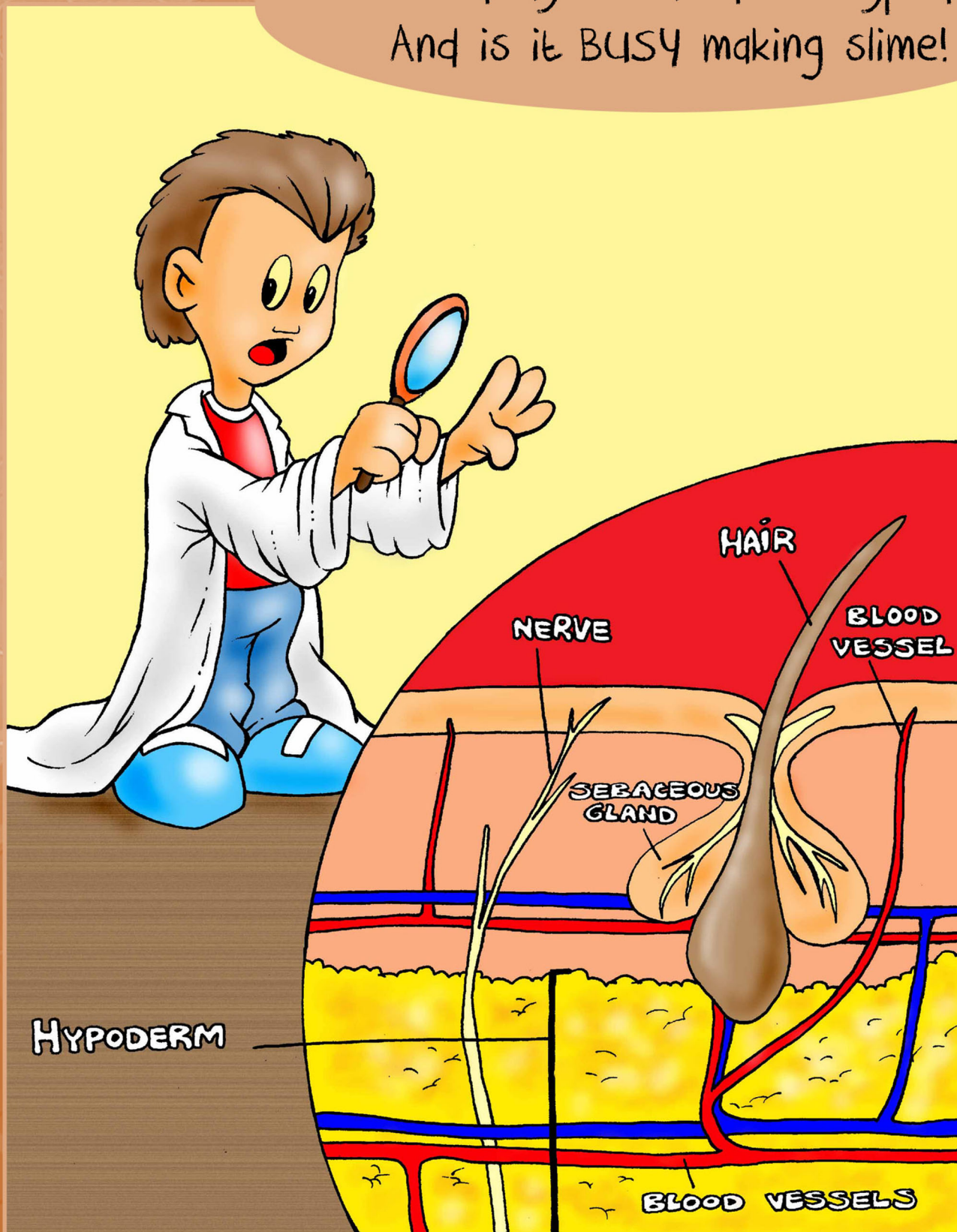


It's made up of three layers

Or oil, so I don't feel rough!

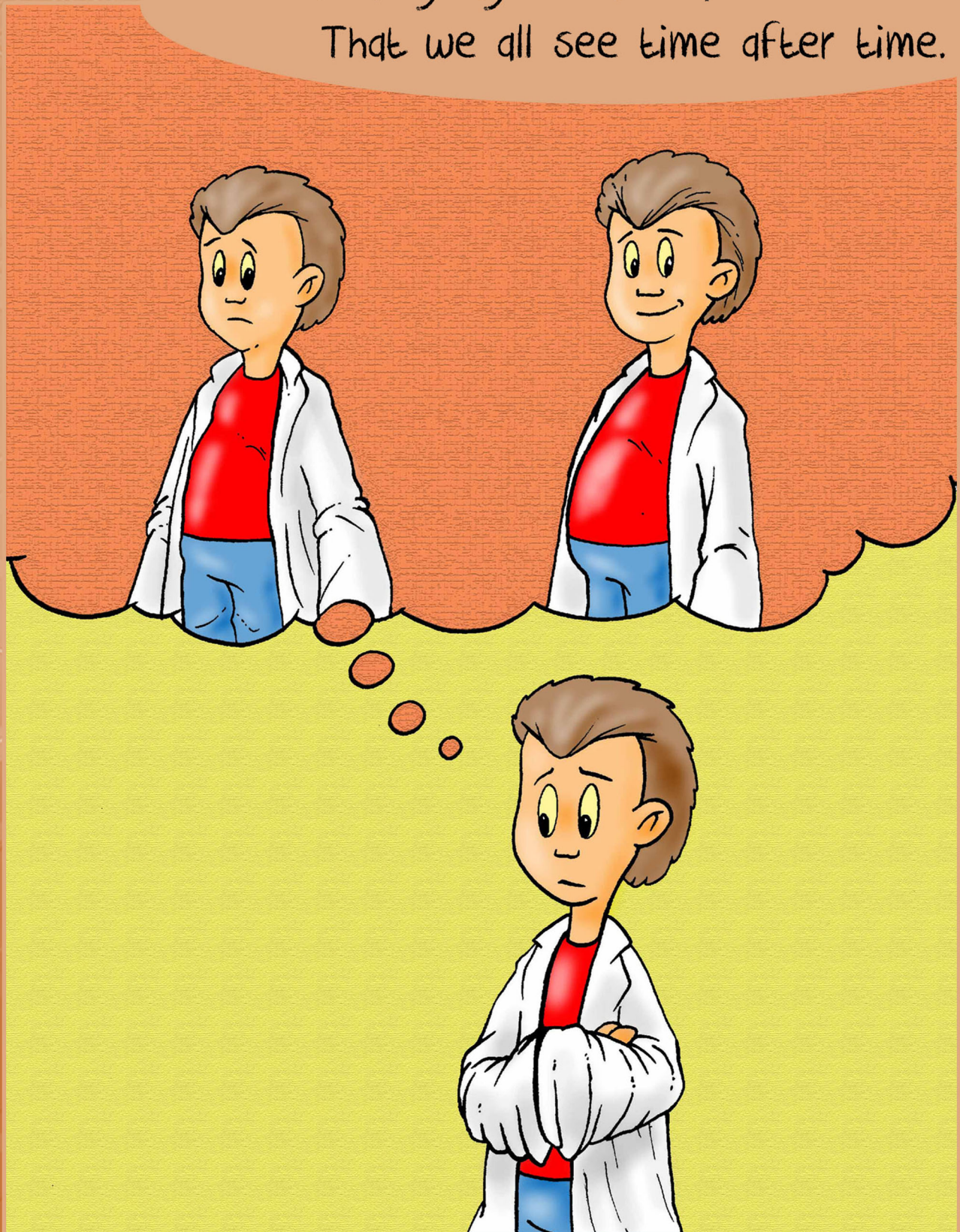


The first layer's called
